Zip Line: More than just an adrenaline rush, the elevated platforms and cables give you the chance to see incredible wildlife from Scarlet Macaws to White-faced Monkeys, as well as breathtaking views of the Nicoya Peninsula.

Tranopy: Open-air trams lift you through the rainforest canopy surrounding Jaco Beach and Los Suenos where gorgeous fauna, trickling waterfalls, hidden streams and exciting wildlife – from Scarlet Macaws to native monkeys – await. On this ascent, your professional naturalist guides describe in intricate detail the unspoiled beauty that surrounds you as they open the conversation up for an enlightening group discussion.

ATV: you will have your motorcycle helmet on and learning the in's and out's of riding your own ATV up in to the rainforest – Mules/Rhinos & tandem ATVs also available for the faint of heart. Within minutes you will be in the secondary rainforest on your way to an amazing Costa Rican waterfall.

Chocolat tour: The Chocolate Experience will start with a short 30-minute walk, where we will introduce you to the Central Pacific transitional forest, during the walk, we can observe the amazing flora and fauna, once the walk is over its time to start with the Chocolate Experience, Vista Los Suenos Adventure Park has the first International Cocoa collection of the Central Pacific.

during this experience you will learn about the different varieties of Cocoa, as well as the ancestral history and the impact on the world economy and the most important part is that you will be able to try the actual Cocoa fruit before the process, also be part of the Cocoa production process, as well as try different types of Chocolat and mix it with tropical fruits. As an additional plus on this experience, you will learn about 2 of the most traditional agricultural products of Costa Rica "Sugar cane" and "Coffee" you will have direct contact with the plants and the natural history of these crops. At the end of the experience, there will be organic chocolate bars with different Cocoa percentages as well as other Cocoa products for purchase.

On your cruise to Tortuga Island, sun-lovers may choose to enjoy the views from the open-air seating, which is available on deck. Air-conditioned, indoor seating is also available, featuring large, port and starboard windows to assure an excellent view of the Pacific while inside.

Surf Lessons: Group lessons are great for families, groups of friends, and couples who only have a few hours to dedicate to surfing during their vacation. Carara National Park Tour: We made a spontaneous stop here, and found that one of the best ways to see wildlife was to look for people with their necks craned, peering into the brush or canopy. We would then stop at a respectful distance, and look where they were looking. More often than not the guide, or one of the birders would invite us over to look through their binoculars or spotting scope while they described the habits of the bird or animal we were seeing.

to 3 hours.

Arenal Volcano: The majestic Arenal Volcano is located within the Arenal Conservation Area. With more than five hundred thousand acres, it conserves 16 reserves between the mountains of Tilarán and Guanacaste. This is one of the areas in Costa Rica with the most natural and biological wealth, it also has an impressive geological complexity, such as the Arenal volcano, which is the volcano with the most perfect cone of all the volcanoes in the world.

POAS Volcano: Poas Volcano National Park houses one of the more popular volcanoes in Costa Rica—a telling superlative for a country with world-famous geothermal activity. But with its spectacular wildlife, informative museum, and variety of hiking trails, the accolade comes as no surprise.

Manuel Antonio National Park tour: Manuel Antonio National Park contains a charming combination of rain forest, beaches, and coral reefs. These beaches are the most beautiful in the country, lined with lush forest. The forest is home to 2 and 3 fingered sloths, toucans, iguanas, the rare and adorable squirrel monkeys, millions of colorful little crabs, and much more. The trail that winds around Punta Catedral affords some spectacular views. The park is easy to reach, south of the town of Quepos in Puntarenas province, and is near a good selection of hotels and restaurants.

Rincon de la Vieja Volcano Tours: Your guide, a native of the Rincón de la Vieja volcano, will help you observe wildlife such as toucans, capuchin monkeys, howler monkeys, turkeys, coatis, and much more. You will stop to see volcanic activity including bubbling clay pots, fumaroles, and a mini crater.

After lunch, you will be driven to the hot springs. Surrounded by tropical dry forest, the Rio Negro hot springs feature ten pools with hot springs naturally heated by the Rincon de la Vieja Volcano. The relaxing mineral waters are crystal clear and totally natural, and the river flows through the pools constantly. fill them with water. Relax and enjoy the luxury of our healing waters. You can also try our volcanic mud "bath", where the volcanic clay mud is applied as a spa "mask", and after it dries, wash it off with a cold shower from the river. The hot spring water will feel great afterwards!

Rafting Once you arrive at the Rio , rafters are gathered together for a thorough safety briefing and team planning session. During this meeting, your knowledgeable rafting guides will review the conditions on the river and the obstacles you might face during your tour.
